Pacific Northwest Society of Engineers Will Hold Its Fifth Annual Session on June 21 and 22.

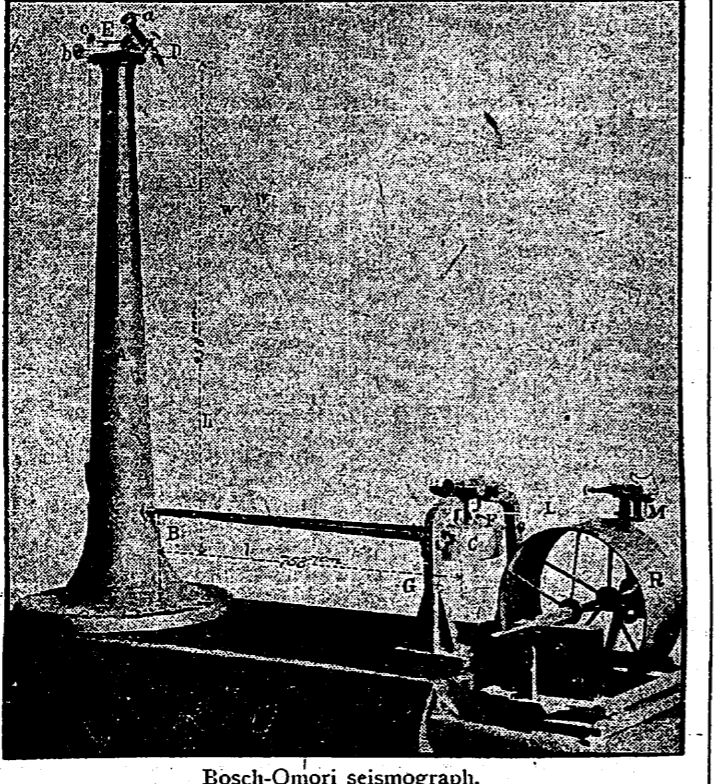
The fifth annual convention of the Pacific Northwest Society of Engineers will be held in the assembly room of the Tacoma Hotel, on June 21st and 22nd.

SPRIT OF REVOLT IN DRAMA IS DISCUSSED

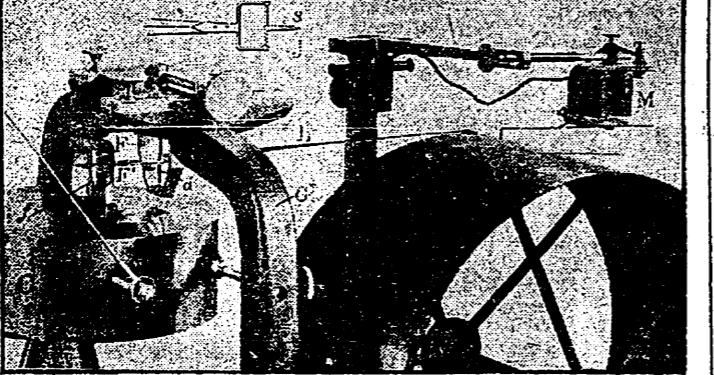
Emma Goldman Reviews Plays by Tolstoy, Ibsen, Hauptmann, Shaw and Yeats in Final Address.

NO DISTURBED BY GRAND JURY

Mayor Moore Says He Is Willing That the Renton Hill Club Should Have an Investigation if One Is Wanted.

If the Renton Hill Improvement Club wants a grand jury it can have one for Mayor W. H. Moore cares. The resolution to be considered by the organization tonight demanding a special inquiry into county and municipal affairs will not disturb the mayor's office of the city's executive. One of the principal reasons why the peace of mind of the mayor was not disturbed was that he did not know the club would take up the resolution until the morning had nearly passed. Then he accepted the incidents as one of those things that come into the life of a public official without doing anything.

"If the Renton Hill Improvement Club wants a grand jury, I don't care," said Mayor Moore this morning. "It is a matter of no concern to me whether a grand jury or anybody else investigates the affairs of the mayor's office. I have not asked that a grand jury look into anybody's else affairs and I am not going to, but if some one wants to include this office in the scope of a grand jury's investigations, it's all right."

DESPONDENT WOMAN COMMITS SUICIDE

Wife of Dr. W. L. Harrison Hangs Herself with Rope Made From Pieces of a Sheet.

Mrs. Emma Harrison, wife of Dr. W. L. Harrison, committed suicide last night by hanging herself with pieces of a sheet, which she had attached to the top of the water tank in the kitchen of her house at 802 1/2 Thirteenth Avenue.

When the deed was committed the woman's 5-year-old daughter was asleep in another room. Her brother-in-law, H. C. Harrison, had just retired to his room shortly before. He said that when he had Mrs. Harrison good-night she appeared in her usual condition. Dr. Harrison can assign no reason for the suicide unless it be despondency over an ailment. He had claimed that Mrs. Harrison several times threatened to end her life.

CLERK STEALS STAMPS TO BUY FINE CIGARS

WILLIAM A. CLAY, formerly a Seattle hotel man, died in New York Tuesday of erysipelas after an illness of but four days. Clay formerly was connected with the Rainier-Grand Hotel in this city. At the outbreak of the Spanish war he enlisted in Company B of the First Washington Regiment, and served with his company throughout the Philippine insurrection, taking part in the capture of Manila.
